The Township of Rideau Lakes is seeking an individual for a seasonal Harbour Master position.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Harbour Master oversees the operation of the Newboro and Portland Harbours while enforcing policies and collecting fees.

EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / SKILLS TRAINING:

- Grade 12 diploma with demonstrated ability to read instructions, write routine notes and reports, record information, and perform calculations.
- Must have a valid G driver's license and reliable transportation to travel between sites.
- Experience in waste and recycling procedures would be an asset.
- Excellent communication abilities and public relations skills.
- Must have experience in dealing with cash, receipts, and accounts receivable reconciliation.
- Must be responsible and able to work in both a team and individual type environment.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collecting parking and dock slip payments and remitting receipts to users.
- Keeping daily and weekly accounting logs to provide to the Manager of Facilities and Parks.
- Providing customer service to boaters/users of the harbours with general inquiries.
- Maintaining the grounds of the Newboro & Portland Harbour sites, Hanna Park/Portland Beach.
- Identifying, reporting and when possible, mitigating safety deficiencies of the docks/grounds.
- Issuing notices of contravention to vehicles/boats who contravene policies/by-laws.
- Performing weekend waste collection at the Newboro & Portland Harbour sites.

The regular working hours for this position are January to April - 8 hours per week (flexible), May 5 to Mid-September, generally Monday to Friday 40 hours per week, some weekends.
